Worker injured on screen mesh

A worker was walking past screen mesh that was stacked up against the hut wall when he caught his leg on a sharp edge of a screen causing a 5cm cut.

The wound required attention at the local medical centre where it was cleaned and glued.



MinEx data on incidents with the potential to cause harm over the past 5 years show 15% of incidents (945 incidents) result in occupational injury.

You need to ensure that:

- 1. Screen mesh and other materials are securely stored so they don't result in a hazard to worker safety.
- 2. All access ways are kept clear of obstructions to eliminate hazards associated with trips, falls and abrasions.
- Regular workplace inspections are conducted to ensure all plant and equipment is securely stored to avoid hazards associated with trips, falls and abrasions.
