## Rock on road near quarry entrance

Early one morning, a truck driver spotted a rock on the entrance road to a quarry. The quarry manager was notified and organised to retrieve the 12cm diameter rock from the road.

In January 2024, over a 17-working day period, there were 34 occasions that rocks had been reported in duals of trucks leaving the quarry.

Such rocks present a travel hazard for other road users.



MinEx statistics on incidents with the potential to cause harm over the past 6 years show 16% of incidents (1,007 incidents) involve falls of which 231 result from fall of ground.

## You need to ensure that:

- 1. You require truck drivers to check the dual tyres on their trucks for rocks that may be caught in them prior to leaving site.
- 2. Haul roads are maintained to reduce the chance of rocks being caught in duals on trucks.
- Regular workplace inspections are conducted to ensure checks such as rocks caught in tyres are being conducted.
