Working under a suspended load

Workers were carrying out maintenance on the fixed plant to repair a split conveyor belt.

The belt was being removed using a franna crane and while it was suspended in the air, a contractor was seen working in the vicinity of the suspended conveyor belt.

MinEx statistics on incidents with the potential to cause harm over the past 6 years show 16% of incidents (1,022 incidents) result from falls of which 385 result from fall of equipment. You need to ensure that:

- 1. No one is in the vicinity of equipment while it is being lifted or manoeuvred into position.
- All risks associated with manoeuvring and securing parts and plant during maintenance are identified and adequately managed.
- 3. Effective supervision and planning are in place to ensure maintenance tasks are conducted safely.
