SAFETY ALERT

Partial de-gloving injury to left hand ring finger.

Brief Description:

While exiting Jumbo 252, Jumbo Operator placed their hand on the cab pillar while exiting the drill and their wedding band caught against the edge of a gauge penetration that was not blanked off. This has resulted in the operator sustaining a laceration requiring 13 sutures to close the injury to their left hand ring finger.

Corrective and Preventative Actions:

- 1. Audit all mobile equipment for potential nip points and rectify with blanking plates or covers
- 2. Re-enforce the following with all crews when entering/exiting equipment, face the unit and maintain three points of contact at all times & avoid twisting and turning where possible.
- 3. Update induction materials all rings/jewellery to be covered or removed
- 4. Develop and distribute information brief to crews -all rings/jewellery to be covered or removed.

Key Learnings:

- 1. Access/ egress into machines must be conducted while facing cab and by maintaining 3 points of contact at all times.
- 2. Nip/ pinch points on machinary should be blanked off or covered.
- 3. Jewellery should be removed whilst at work or at the very least be covered accordingly to elimanate the chance of injury caused form pinch points or entanglement.
